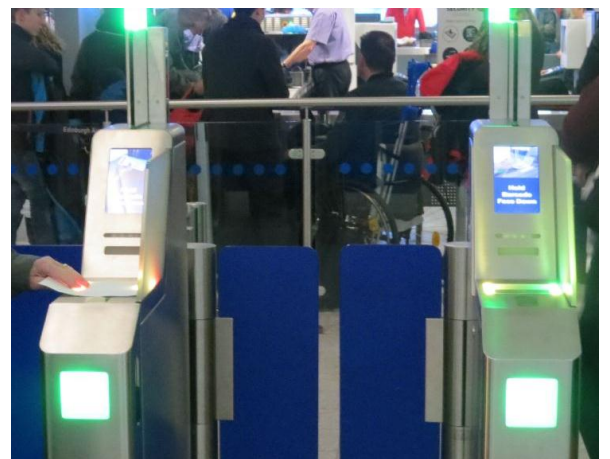
1 Be prepared

- We know that the security process can be daunting and stressful but do not worry, we are here to help you.
- Before you enter security take time to make sure you have your boarding pass and identification ready and you have a clear plastic bag for any liquids.
- You can get these bags at the entrance to security.
- If you have any liquids, they must be less than 100ml.
- You can find out more about liquid rules at edinburghairport.com/security.



2 Entering the security hall

- Before entering the security hall you will need to have your boarding pass and identification scanned.
- This can be done by a member of security staff or by yourself using one of our e-gates.
- If you need help or have any questions just ask a security staff member.

Going through security

- The security hall is a busy place and you may have to stand in a queue.
- Our security staff are here to help guide you through the machines as easily and quickly as possible.
- Please make sure you are ready before arriving at the conveyer belt.
- Take a grey tray and place any hats, scarves, jackets, boots, watches, liquids and electronic items in here.
- This will then go through the security scanner.
- You are now ready to go through the security archway once a security staff member instructs you to do so.
- You may also have to stand in a short queue here.
- If you have any additional requirements or concerns please speak to a staff member who will assist you.
- If the scanner beeps don't worry, a staff member will perform a body search on top of your clothes.
- You may be subject to a further search in our body scanner, this is perfectly safe and happens many times each day. More information on this is available at edinburghairport.com/prepare
- Once you are through the archway you can collect your belongings.
- Please take your time to put your shoes and outdoor clothing back on and pack your things away safely.
- You can now make your way to the departure lounge.
